The Prayer Breakfast will be held at the Denny Sanford Premier Center on March 24, with doors opening at 6:30 a.m. and the program running from 7-8:30 a.m. The first 300 attendees will receive a hot breakfast, which will include a breakfast sandwich or breakfast burrito, yogurt and fruit; coffee and milk will be available.
